SERVICE SUPERVISOR (SS)

FULL TIME- PERMANENT POSITION

The Service Supervisor provides progressive leadership in all aspects of case management, including management and administration, along with supervisory case collaboration with agency and community stakeholders.

The Service Supervisor will provide supervisory coverage and manage the staffing of the team for ensuring the safety and well-being of children; and, provide clinical supervision and manage cases in accordance with member First Nations community based models, Agency policies and the Ministry of Child and Youth Services standards and regulations.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited university in a discipline deemed appropriate for the position. An Honours BSW is preferred.
- At least (3) years' of successful employment experience within a child welfare environment with progressive levels of responsibility, including (2) years of in front-line service delivery of Child Welfare Services.

Other qualifications preferred for these positions include:

- Experience in an Aboriginal social service agency is an asset.
- Ability to speak Anishinabemowin is a definite asset.
- Knowledge of First Nations issues as they relate to child welfare and a willingness to work in partnership with First Nations families, Elders and communities to provide best practice for First Nations children and families.
- Strong commitment to helping Anishinabe children and their families by providing services in ways that respect Anishinabe cultural and spiritual practices.
- Commitment to providing service in the Anishinabe context of extended family and community involvement.
